

Paternity Fraud

Paternity fraud is the false identification of a man as the father of a child.

It is a serious problem in the US and throughout the world. Situations occur where some men are assigned paternity obligations by simply being named as the father by a woman.

Over 30% of the children in the United States are born to unwed mothers.

Approximately 30% of the over 300,000 paternity tests performed annually in the United States result in exclusion of the alleged individual as the biological father.

The LA Chapter of the National Coalition of Free Men estimates that there are over 7 million children in the United States that are unknowingly calling the wrong person, Dad.

Paternity Fraud or the false identification of a man as the father of a child, forces thousands of men each year to pay for children fathered by other men.
